

Lesson 2.6 Moving windows

In this section you'll learn to change the location of a window. Note that these commands are only appropriate for windows that aren't maximized.

Table 2.6: Moving windows

Say	To
Window 0-100 By 0-100	move the current window so its top left corner is on specific vertical and horizontal screen coordinates
Window 1-100 By Window By 1-100	move the current window so its top left corner is on a given vertical coordinate move the current window so its top left corner is on a given horizontal coordinate
Window 1-100 Left	move the current window to the left 1-100 increments
Window 1-100 Right	move the current window to the right 1-100 increments
Window 1-100 Up	move the current window up 1-100 increments
Window 1-100 Down	move the current window down 1-100 increments


Moving by coordinates

To move a window so that the top left corner of the window is positioned at given coordinates

- say "Window" followed by a vertical coordinate, followed by "By", followed by a horizontal coordinate

Examples: **"Window 45 By 45"** moves the top left corner of the active window near the middle of the screen:

Figure 2.6a: "Window 45 By 45"



"Window 10 By 10" puts the top left corner of the window near the top left of the screen:

Figure 2.6b: "Window 10 By 10"
